

**PharmD Application Checklist**  
**University of Iowa College of Pharmacy**

- Be on track to complete all pre-pharmacy coursework.
- Be on track to complete at least 12 semester hours of general education electives.
- In the fall semester before the year in which you are seeking admission, apply via PharmCAS.
- Complete the (required) Pharmacy College Admission Test (PCAT) prior to the January 2020 application deadline. Send scores to PharmCAS using Code #104.

**Notes:**

We will *not* accept scores sent directly to the University of Iowa.  
Scores from any January PCAT will be accepted for that year's fall admission.  
PCAT scores are valid for 2 years.

- Get and submit two letters of reference. Process them through the PharmCAS application service.
- Be aware that personal interviews are required.

**Candidates will be contacted by the college if selected for an interview late this calendar year or early next year.**
